

SPRING RECREATIONAL INFORMATION

FEES AND REFUNDS

The registration fee is \$105 for the regular Spring season (\$90 for T-Ball). For each additional sibling the fee is reduced by \$5. A \$20 discount will be available for those registering before January 6, 2004. A written request is required for all refunds. A full refund is available until teams are selected. A 50% refund is available until the team's first practice. No refunds will be issued after the teams have had their first practice. PGSL will assess a \$20 fee for nonpayment of a check.

DIVISIONS AND TRYOUTS

Players are assigned to divisions according to their league age. League age is determined by year of birth according to the table below. Tryouts will be held on Jan 10 & 17, 2004 at times determined by player's birth year according to the table below. Players MUST tryout with their year group regardless of where they will or would like to play. Rookies who would like to be considered for Division 1 may try out with the 1993 year group.

PLAYER PLACEMENT REQUESTS

It is not the policy of Poway Girls Softball to allow players to play outside of their age division though it is occasionally necessary due to staffing, team selection, or safety considerations. If, due to unusual circumstances, you have a special placement request, please inform the Player Agent by noting on the registration form. This is NOT a guarantee that your request will be granted.

UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT

Uniform jerseys, visors, and socks will be provided by the league. Players must provide their own black shorts. Bats, balls, helmets, and catcher's gear will be provided by the league. Players must provide their own glove. Players may use their own bat and/or helmet provided they meet ASA specifications. All helmets must have a chinstrap and a mask or cage attached. Shirts in a variety of sizes will be provided for the team, distribution of these uniforms will be left to the coach or team parent.
